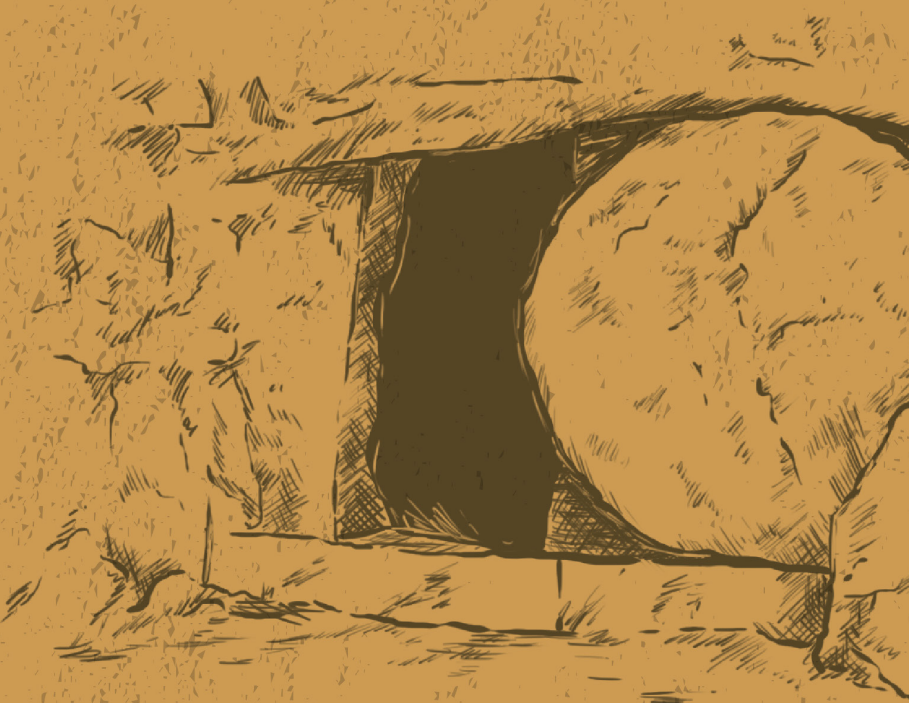

His Victory Won – John 20 (p. 906) & 1 Corinthians 15 (p. 961)
