Johnny Miller, Pastor Emeritus and former Senior Pastor of Calvary Church (1999-2009), went to be with the Lord on Easter Sunday morning, at the age of 81, after a nearly 15-year battle with Parkinson's disease. Pastor Miller was widely known and deeply loved for his faithful exposition of God's Word and Christlike pastoral leadership. His ministry left a lasting impact on many lives, both here at Calvary and beyond. A celebration of life service will be held in Columbia, SC, on Wednesday, April 30, at 2:30pm.
