Titus: Truth That Shapes Us

How Our Lives Make the Gospel Beautiful – Titus 2:1-10 (p. 998)

What message might our lives be sending to dear ones we know who are still far from God? In chapter two, the apostle Paul instructs Titus to challenge the young church on ancient Crete to reflect by their character and conduct the gospel's power to transform.

The Charge for Leaders: Keep Casting Vision for the Gospel-Transformed Life (v. 1)

The “healthy doctrine” – salvation by faith in Christ alone (v. 10, 11-15)

The “fitting” behavior – lives transformed by the gospel

The Charge for All of Us: Keep Pursuing the Gospel-Transformed Life (v. 2-10)

The gospel is transformative regardless of our age, gender, marital status, or vocation
