



Paul's Purpose

Verse 1

Faith means believing something is and committing our to it.

Really understanding what God has done for us by saving us gives us three things: humility, security and passion.

WHO IS TITUS?

Verse 4 tells us that Paul loved Titus like a father loves his son.

To Titus, my true in a common faith:
