



## **WHAT ARE PROVERBS?**

They are short, common sense instructions. We are being wise when we apply them to our everyday life!

**Proverbs 26:11** "Like a dog that returns to his vomit is a \_\_\_\_\_ who repeats his folly."

What!? A dog eating its own vomit? Disgusting! Crazy! Why?! This proverb says that we are a lot like that dog when we keep doing the same foolish thing over and over again!

Proverbs are true, but they are incomplete. We have to think carefully about what they mean and about our situation to know how to apply them.
