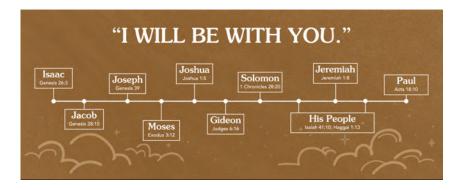
Verse 29 Circle the words that tell us Mary was afraid.
