



PRAYER IS A _____

The creator of the universe, God, is saying, “Come talk to me. I love you and want to have time with you.”

PRIORITIES OF PRAYER

Luke 11:1 Now Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he finished, one of the disciples said to him, “Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.”

What did the disciples ask Jesus to teach them? _____

Luke 11:2-4 and He said to them, “When you pray, say:

“Father, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come.

Give us each day our daily bread,

and forgive us our sins,

for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us

and lead us not into temptation

PERSISTENCE IN PRAYER

Luke 11:5-7 And he said to them, “Which of you who has a _____ will go to him at midnight and say to him, “Friend, lend me three loaves, for a friend of mine has arrived on a _____, and I have nothing to set before him; and he will answer from within, ‘Do not _____ me; the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed. I cannot get up and give you anything’?

We are like the friend who needs bread. In need and desperate!

Luke 11:8 “I tell you, though he will not get up and give him anything because he is his friend, yet because of his **impudence** he will rise and give him whatever he needs.”

This means: 
*being bold and
continuing to ask.*

Luke 11:9-10 “And I tell you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened.”

When you stop praying, you don't stop needing!



What are things you do instead of talking to God?

Luke 11:11-13 “What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent; or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”

Put a **rectangle** around the gift that our heavenly father will give us.

We are not knocking on a stranger’s door when we pray to God.
We are coming to our Father’s house!

PERSEVERANCE IN PRAYER

Luke 18:1 And he told them a parable to the effect that they ought always to pray and not lose heart.

Put a **heart** around the reason Jesus told this parable.
