

Psalm 67 (p. 481)

For over 88 years, Calvary Church has been committed to *Going into God's World*. But what fuels that commitment? Is missions driven mainly by human need or by God's glory? Psalm 67 reveals that God blesses His people, so that His saving power and praise would spread to all nations. So, today, we'll understand why the mission of God has always been central to the heart of God, and why it must remain central for us.
