The Gospel

The Good News of Grace - Ephesians 2 (p. 976)

The gospel is the story of God dealing graciously with undeserving people. Paul contrasts man's character with God's character to reveal God's glorious rescue of His people. This gracious offer of salvation demands a faith response and should lead us to live relationally in the family of God.

The Gloriousness of God's Gospel (1:6)

The Problem: Man's Character Revealed (2:1-3)

Who He Is: God's Glorious Character Revealed (2:4)

What He Did: God's Gracious Response (2:5-7)

Our Necessary Response: Saving Faith (2:8-10)

The Relational Call: Live as Sons and Daughters (2:19-22)

Reflection and Action: How have you personally responded to the grace God has shown you?
