The Good News of Mercy – Titus 3:1-8 (page 998)

Titus 3 shows us that the gospel doesn't just change our eternal destination it transforms our daily relationships. Once foolish and enslaved, we have been saved by God's mercy, renewed by His Spirit, and made heirs of eternal life. The mercy we receive from God becomes the mercy we extend to others.
