THE PROBLEM: Man's Character (verses 1-3)

Verse 1 says that we were _____ in our trespasses and sins.

If we think our sin is no big deal, then we will never understand or appreciate how glorious God's grace is!

WHO HE IS: God's Glorious Character (verse 4)
