Not Home Yet: A Study of 1 Peter
Identity – 1 Peter 1:3-12 (page 1014)

Today we'll explore what it means to live as those who are *not home yet* but never lost—because, in Christ, our great salvation tells us who we are and where we are going.

We are *not home yet*, but in Christ we have:

a mercy-born identity (1:3)

a secure hope (1:3-5)

a trial-refined faith (1:6-7)

a gospel-shaped story of Glory (1:8-12)

Reflection and Action: When life reminds us we are not home yet, where do we look for our identity, hope, and security—to what is perishable around us, or the living hope we have in Christ?
