Prepare Your Mind: focus on the things God will do in your life.

Sober-Mindedness: becoming aware of what we allow to have our attention and shape our thoughts, desires, and actions.

We want our thoughts to be Christ-centered.

1 Peter 1:14-16

As do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, but as **he who called you is holy**, you also be holy in **all** your conduct, since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

Because God made you His child, you live out of your new identity and obey Him.

Holiness helps us grow aware of the work that the Holy Spirit is doing in us. We can ask, "Am I listening to **my** desires or the **Spirit's** desires?"

Say whatever you want

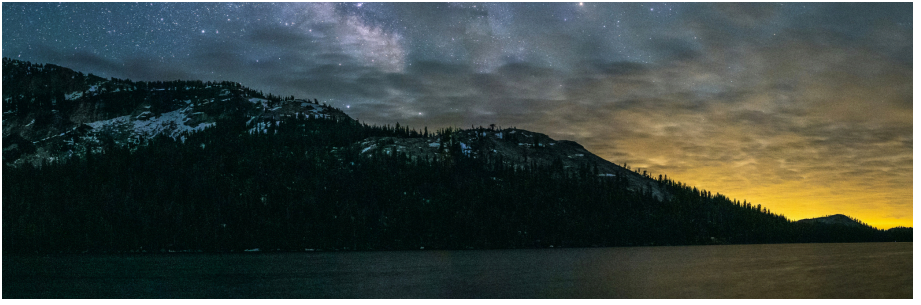
Speak with grace
